## **NET BOOKING CONFIRMATION:**

Thank you for taking the time to consider booking the Ashburton roll-on net / training facilities.

Please take the time to read the below, in relation to how the club has adapted the facilities to cater for your needs.

Before training, check for symptoms of <u>COVID-19</u>. In line with current Government guidance, if you are symptomatic, living in a household with a possible COVID-19 infection or if you are classified as extremely vulnerable on health grounds, you should remain at home and follow Government guidance.

Avoid public transport if at all possible.

ECB has provided detailed guidance on the preparation and administration of outdoor facilities for clubs, and guidelines for participation for individuals. The situation is evolving constantly, and we will continue to update our guidance as more information becomes available.

Further advice is available at the <u>GOV.UK</u> and <u>Sport England</u> websites. Please regularly check these sites and the updated ECB guidance as this policy position is likely to change over time and could also become more regionalised and localised as time progresses.

Upon arrival to Varwell Field, you will be greeted by a locked gate. Please contact Lloyd White to obtain the key code to unlock the gate.

- The pavilion will remain locked at all times.
- No toilets will be provided on site and therefore, please take this into consideration
- On the old pavilion foundations, you will see a locked storage cabinet. This contains all the cricket equipment you should require;
  - o Balls
  - Training Materials
  - o Stumps
  - Bowling Machine
  - o First Aid Kit
  - Hand sanitiser
- Wash hands at home before and after using the outdoor facilities.
- Bring your own hand sanitiser where possible.
- No saliva or sweat should come into contact with the ball at any time.
- Social distancing of at least two metres must be maintained at all times (unless all participants are members of the same household).

## USING OUTDOOR CRICKET FACILITIES DURING LOCKDOWN IN ENGLAND





Do not use the facility if you, or a member of your household has symptoms of coronavirus however mild - observe government advice.



Wash your hands thoroughly before and after using the facility. Practice good hygiene at all times.



Observe social distancing rules at all times.



Usage should be booked with the club. No unauthorised use.



Maximum six people using the facilities together



Coaching can now take place with small groups of up to six (including the coach)



Adjacent nets not to be used (but every other net is ok, if users maintain social distance).



Use your own equipment if possible.

No sweat or saliva should be applied to the ball at any time.



Please maintain 10 minutes between bookings.
